ORD-0002-2000

TO AMEND CHAPTER 1171, FENCES, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, TO AMEND SECTIONS ON SWIMMING POOL FENCES AND INVISIBLE FENCES; AND TO UPDATE REFERENCES TO ZONING OFFICER TO ZONING ADMINISTRATOR.

Payne stated the change requested in December is in the ordinance; Section 1171.05(C) (B) has the language inserted as follows: "However, if said gate is an attended gate while pool is open, said gate shall not need to be self closing and self latching."

Discussion held on number of code section 339.13; should be 339.12; make necessary corrections; treat as typographical error.

With regard to necessary equipment, Chief is to speak to Director of Public Service regarding the bid process on the scales and vehicle; will come back to committee when ready for next step.

Weber stated he wanted to raise the penalty clause for more of a deterrent; a minor misdemeanor is a small fine and large company will pay as part of doing business; this gives more clout to the Police Department and Court for enforcement.
