

TO AMEND SECTION 331.34, FAILURE TO CONTROL; WEAVING; FULL TIME AND ATTENTION, OF CHAPTER 331, OPERATION GENERALLY, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA

WHEREAS, the City of Gahanna is amending this section of code to further align with Chapter 331 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 331.34, Failure to Control; Weaving; Full Time Attention, of Chapter 331, Operation Generally, is hereby amended as shown in EXHIBIT A attached hereto.

Section 2. That any ordinance or ordinances in conflict hereto are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage by this Council and 30 days after date of signature of approval by the Mayor.

EXHIBIT A

331.34 FAILURE TO CONTROL; WEAVING; FULL TIME AND ATTENTION.

(a) No person shall operate a vehicle without exercising reasonable and ordinary control over such vehicle.

(b) No person shall operate a vehicle in a weaving or zigzag course unless such irregular course is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law.

(c) No person shall operate a vehicle without giving his full time and attention to the operation of such vehicle.

(d) **Whoever violates subsection (a) or (b) of this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense; on each subsequent offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.** Whoever violates **subsection (c) of this section** is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree on a first offense; on a second offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree; on each subsequent offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree.
