Local resident (Advocate) identifies a need in the community and submits the need through the Neighborhood Bridges website.

Need is Vetted

Area Director of community then insures that all information is collected from the Advocate about the need (contact information, any specific information)

Need is Posted/Filled

Need is posted on Neighborhood Bridges website to go out as an Alert to the community (Subscribers) of the need.

Subscribers alert Area Director to help fill need. Coordination is made with Advocate to deliver from Donor to Recipient.
