### **ACTION ITEM FROM THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR**

#### **Action Item – Ordinance–Rumpke Refuse Collection Contract Addendum #1**

Council has recently approved legislation that authorized the Mayor to enter into contract with Rumpke for solid waste collection services for years 2019, 2020, and 2021.

On November, 26 Gahanna received Addendum #1 to this contract that addresses the following:

1. The Addendum reiterates that the contract is only for 3 years and that the optional extension years of 2022 and 2023 may be mutually agreed upon by both parties at an adjusted rate. (This is the exact same wording that is in the contract and we aren't sure why they would want it reiterated in the addendum.)
2. The Addendum also states that Rumpke will not be responsible for maintaining or replacing community provided carts unless we are paying the surcharge fee for maintenance of those carts. (While this is not specifically stated in the contract, this would have been our understanding of Rumpke's level of responsibility for any community-provided carts.)

We are respectfully requesting legislation that authorizes the Mayor to sign Addendum #1 to Rumpke's (solid waste collection contract. So that this addendum is valid and in effect January 1, 2019, we also ask that this legislation be passed as emergency with a waiver of second reading.
