CHAPTER 135 Department of Public Service

135.01 DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE.

- (a) The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed, in addition to his other duties, as provided by Charter, to carry out the duties assigned by this Chapter and such other duties as may be provided by Ordinance.
- (b) The hours worked, vacation and other employment benefits set out in the unclassified salary ordinance shall apply to the Director of Public Service. (Ord. 107-94. Passed 6-21-94.)

135.011 EMPLOYMENT OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE. The Mayor is authorized and directed when such position is deemed necessary to employ a Deputy Director of Public Service for the City.

(a) Qualifications. The qualifications of the Deputy Director of Public

Service shall be as follows:

(1) Graduate of an accepted college or university in the field of engineering or equivalent. WITH MAJOR COURSEWORK IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION OR RELATED FIELD AND EXTENSIVE PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE PUBLIC WORKS OPERATIONS EXPERIENCE.

(2) Duly licensed to practice engineering in the State.

(3) A minimum of five years of practical experience in the field of engineering at the operating and supervision level.

(b) Duties. The Deputy Director of Public Service shall:

Work under the general direction of the Director of Public Service and shall serve as the Director in the Director's absence.

(2) ACT AS THE UTILITIES/RIGHT OF WAY MANAGER. Have the responsibility of directing all of those engineering functions in the matters of construction and maintenance undertaken by the Sewer and Water Division, the Street Division, and other public work projects undertaken by the City, and such other duties as may be imposed from time to time by Council.

(3) Direct the preparation and processing of all Federal funding requests of the City, unless otherwise designated by the Mayor.

(4) Perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Director of Public Service. (Ord. 107-94. Passed 6-21-94.)
