March 18th, 2024 resolution was approved authorizing the City to participate in Power a Clean Future Ohio (PCFO)

The resolution created a commitment to reduce Green House Gas emissions within the City of Gahanna by 50% of 2010 levels by 2030.

The City of Gahanna manages sixty-seven (67) electric accounts. These accounts are for municipal operations; including city facilities, pump stations, streetlights, etc.

Utilizing over 4.2 million/kWh annually, upcoming considerations;

- o 200 S. Hamilton Rd

Current agreement runs 11/30/2020 - 11/29/2025 at a rate of \$.04121/kWh

Indicative pricing for 12-month term for supplier

- o Traditional \$.07081/kWh
- o 100% Renewable \$.07336/kWh

Estimated impact from 11/30/2025 - 11/29/2026

- o ~\$125k increase to "Traditional"
- o ~\$136k increase if "100% Renewable"
