## **UPDATE ITEMS**

## DISCUSSION ITEM #1: COMPREHENSIVE PARKS AND RECREATION MASTER PLAN PRESENTATION

In 2006, City Council adopted the Department of Parks and Recreation Comprehensive Master Plan. The Plan has served as a guide to make decisions regarding policies, programs, operations, maintenance and capital improvements. The creation of the Parks and Recreation Foundation, pricing policy, cost recovery model and strategies, athletic user affiliate agreement, and the multiuse trail plan are just a few initiatives that have been implemented and that have benefited the Parks and Recreation Department as a result of the 2006 Master Plan. In 2015, the operational aspects of the Plan were updated, but were not formally adopted by City Council.

In 2022, City Council approved the funds to update the Parks and Recreation Master Plan. With the guidance of Pros Consultants, the master plan procoss is in its final stages and is prepared for Council's evaluation prior to seeking adoption.
