

Request Summary

- Major Development Plan to keep the exterior pink color.
 - Portions of the building were painted pink in September
 - Application submitted due to Code Enforcement action
 - Light pink Sherwin Williams "alyssum"
 - Includes south side of building, part of west side, gutters, soffits, columns, stairs, doors
 - Building used to have a medium green accent color
 - Any color not explicitly listed in the Zoning Code requires a DP
 - If the pink color is not approved, the applicant will paint the building SW "softer tan", which is a permitted color

Request Summary

Major Development Plan Criteria

- Development meets the applicable development standards of the Zoning Ordinance
- Development is in accord with appropriate plans for the area
- Development would not have undesirable effects on the surrounding area
- Development would be in keeping with the existing land use character and physical development potential of the area

Request Summary

- Staff recommends <u>disapproval</u> of Major Development Plan
 - Pink south side of building visible from Granville St
 - Creekside has stricter design guidelines than other zoning districts
 - Staff has <u>no objection</u> to the "softer tan" color as it meets Code
