ACTION ITEMS:

COUNCIL UPDATES:

PARKS DIVISION

- Continued weekly mow and trim rotation at every park
- Laid sod around new McCorkle park playground
- Jim Ferguson attended training classes for Turf License

FACILITIES DIVISION

- Patched and spot painted Swim Club front pool
- Winterizing both pools
- Installed new decking on accessible ramp at Herb Center
- Playground and safety surface installed at McCorkle by contractor
- New water line installed at Geroux Garden shed for irrigation

ARBOR/HORTICULTURAL DIVISION

- Pruned 102 trees; mostly street trees
- Removed 56 street trees; mostly park trees
- 9/3 planted 60 mums at Creekside
- 9/4 planted 4 trees at Upper McCorkle Park; one deciduous (shade) and three evergreen
- 9/4 planted 3 trees at Rice Ave. Park; one deciduous (shade) and two evergreen
- 9/11 planted 18 deciduous trees at Hannah Park and removed Willow and Cottonwood trees from the Bio-swales with 36 volunteers from Columbus Academy; 108 total volunteer hours
- 9/28 planted 8 Arborvitae 8ft. tall at herb garden
- Weed control at Creekside Plaza
- Weed control at Gramercy park
- Removed 6 truckloads Honeysuckle and brush from western and northern fence rows at Upper McCorkle

- Weed control at Upper McCorkle in preparation for seeding
- Continue watering in new trees and flower pots at Creekside
- Planted Mums and Asters for Convention Visitor Bureau event at Herb Center and moved them to Creekside for special event
- Resolved 17 citizen request
- Pesticide applications at various parks
- Completed 5 new home tree inspections

GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

- Aeriated greens by deep tine
- Seeded and fertilized greens
- Fertilized fairways, tee boxes, and rough areas
- Started to aerate and seed fairways
- Shut down irrigation to practice green
- Reduced area of bunker on hole #1

RECREATION DIVISION

Late August/September Events

- Hosted 3 5k's (Children's Hospital duck race, Mifflin Fire Department, Melanoma), these events combined fundraised over \$100,000 towards non-profit charities.
- Gahanna Parks & Recreation Foundation Creekside Hops & Vines
 - Over 600 in attendance
 - Raised over \$20,000 for Foundation to be used for an expanded recreation scholarship program along with other Foundation initiatives

Recreation Programs

- Enrolled 273 participants into recreation programs in September
- Introduced new programs
 - Sporties for shorties
 - Square dancing
 - Nature walks
 - New Herb Center classes
 - Painting classes at Sr. Center

Herb Center

- Hosted a group of 50 out-of-state visitors from Missouri. Herb Center did an herbal workshop at golf course clubhouse in partnership with the Gahanna CVB.
- Herb Center has partnered with Whole Foods at Easton. Two of our employees, Brooke Sackenheim and Jenn Schneller have done classes at Whole Foods demonstrating herbs.
- Hosted drying days on three dates, open to public, where they harvest herbs from gardens and dry onsite at Herb Center for future use for classes & product.
- Brooke Sackenheim presented a webinar to the national organization, Herb Society of America, with an audience of over 300 people.

Athletic Fields

- Began field audits with goal to understand who is using our fields and when. Working on plan to rework field use policy for department.
- Negotiated agreement with tournament organization of the Ohio Champions League to host approximately 140 soccer teams on 10/17 & 10/18.

Active Adults & Active Seniors

- Retirement parties for Danise Hall will be held on Monday, October 26 from 5-7pm at Rusty Bucket (for Parks & Rec Department) and Tuesday, October 27 from 4-6pm at The Center (for Senior members).
- Monthly Open Houses are being held and the Welcome Team is being further developed to increase membership. 2016 Membership drive will begin soon.
- Facility renovations/updates are scheduled for December 19-January 3.

ADMINISTRATION

- BTAC notes from last three meetings are attached for Council review.
- Centerpoint church property acquisition on McCutcheon Road continues to move forward.
- VFW Acquisition and lease agreement development continues.
- Gahanna Woods Vernal Pool Preservation (Foxwood Acquisition) continues to progress.
- BWT 5 project is well underway.
- Foundation discussions include expanded scholarship programs and messaging.
- Citywide budget being developed, nearly complete. Significant impact to parks budget from healthcare reform act.
- New lighting being installed on Creekside Island. Concrete poles with LED light engines.
