2020 SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT - PERMISSION TO BID

In late 2019, the City conducted its annual CCTV project in which it inspected and cleaned 14 miles of sewer lines on the west side. The information gathered from this maintenance and inspection project has presented an opportunity to conduct proactive maintenance on these lines, which will include heavy cleaning and 1.1 miles of pipe lining. Although this was not in the original budget for 2020, we are respectfully requesting a motion to permit formal bidding of this project, to take place this year. We believe that, in light of recent historic wet weather events, it is necessary to move forward with this project as soon as possible to help us to improve our sanitary service for our residents.
