Item #1 – Ordinance – Fireworks Contract

We are requesting an ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into contract with Rozzi Inc. dba Rozzis' Famous Fireworks PO Box 5, Loveland, OH 45140 to furnish and launch the fireworks display on July 4, 2017; in the amount of \$20,000 from account 101432.5421 Recreation Rec Program Services; authorizing a deposit payment of \$4,000 due upon signing of contract and the balance of \$16,000 to be paid within 10 days after completion of the fireworks.

The rain date will be July 5, 2017.
