SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - Police Overtime/LLEBG Grant

Hogan asked how many police officers were going to the training on the 12th. Chief answered it will be 12 or 13, including myself. Hogan asked how is that going to affect the police force on hand and overtime. Chief answered that it won't; we revamped the schedules last month; we will only be gone for 5 days; leave on Monday; train on Tuesday through Thursday; leave Friday; shifts have been covered; officers who are going have agreed to an 8 hour day; we will be staying in barracks. Hogan asked under training can we only pay them for 8 hours. Chief answered that they are going in agreement beforehand. Hogan stated that he doesn't want somebody to come back later and say we owe them 20 hours of overtime. Hogan asked if the total cost is in the budget. Chief stated that there shouldn't be any cost; we will need a rental van; training is just training; this is a state of the art facility; no other police department in Columbus has trained there; will be excellent training.
