# Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) Representative Report to City Council April 21, 2025

#### **MORPC Board of Commissioners Meeting**

- The Commission met on April 10, 2025. Due to changes in Ohio Revised Code 121.221 regarding public bodies and virtual meetings, the Commission/Transportation Policy Committee Meeting was aired via live stream.
- <u>Upcoming Commission Meeting</u>: May 8, 2025

<u>April Legislative Update:</u> The Ohio House passed its budget, including brownfield funds and rail commission reinstatement, while energy legislation debates continue. <u>Read the April Legislative Update & Budget Highlights</u>.

- Bills to Watch:
  - 1. **House Bill 54 Transportation Budget (FY 2026-27)**: Allocates funding for transportation projects.
    - *Status: Enacted (3/31/2025)*
  - 2. **HB 96 Operating Budget (FY 2026-27)**: State appropriations for FY 2026-27, reflecting the Governor's recommendations.
    - Status: Passed by the House (4/9/2025)
  - 3. **Senate Bill 2/House Bill 15 Energy Generation**: Changes to public utilities and electric company property taxation, repealing parts of HB 6.
    - Status: SB 2 Passed by Senate (3/19/2025); HB 15 Passed by House (3/26/2025)
  - 4. House Bill 28 Replacement Property Tax Levies: Eliminates the ability of local governments to levy replacement property taxes.
    - Status: 1st Hearing Senate Ways & Means (4/9/2025)
  - 5. **House Bill 109 Short Term Rentals**: Limits local government regulation of short-term rentals and extends lodging taxes.
    - Status: 1st Hearing House Development Committee (3/26/2025)

- Summary of Operating Budget (As Passed by the House):
  - o No Passenger Rail Funding: Advocacy for \$2 million/year for Corridor ID and \$3 million for an Office of Passenger Rail was not included.
  - o MIPRC Membership: Ohio rejoined the Midwest Interstate Passenger Rail Commission.
  - o Brownfield & Demolition: \$125 million/year for Brownfield Remediation and \$21.5 million/year for demolition.
  - o Housing Incentives: \$2.5 million/year for pro-housing policies, expanded Welcome Home Ohio eligibility.
  - o CRAs: Extends CRAs to 30 years for megaprojects.
  - o Eminent Domain for Trails: Bans eminent domain for recreational trails.
  - o Lead Abatement: \$250,000 for local lead abatement.
  - o County Coroners: Appointed by commissioners instead of elected.
  - o Zoning Referenda: Exempts megaproject zoning from referendum.
  - o Pay Raises: 5% raises for public officials, COLA capped at 3% after 2030.
- Transportation Budget (Enacted): Reduced CORPO Funding: Reduced from \$5 million/year to \$3 million/year.
- Comprehensive Energy Legislation: Two similar energy bills, HB 15 and SB 2, are advancing through the Ohio Statehouse, with support from groups like the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, Ohio Manufacturers' Association, and environmental organizations. Both bills have passed their originating chambers and are now with the respective energy committees. The provisions in both bills are generally pro-consumer.
- Community Project Funding: Congress will soon begin negotiating the FY 2026 federal budget, offering a key chance to submit local project funding proposals.
