Re: Proposal for Engineering Services
Additional Improvements to North High Street

Dear Mr. Wetherholt:

As requested, the following is our proposal for engineering services for additional improvements to North High Street between Granville Avenue and Carpenter Road.

The additional improvements to be added to the construction plans now being prepared will consist of installing street lighting, replacing the existing sanitary sewer between Granville Avenue and Town Street, and enhancing the islands which now separate the parking areas, primarily along the west side of the street.

The street lighting will be decorative lighting, matching that already installed in other areas of Old Gahanna. Plans will include pole locations, circuiting, duct, and pull box locations.

The existing sanitary sewer between Town Street and Granville Avenue was recently televised. Most of the joints in this line have deteriorated and the pipe itself is in questionable condition and should be replaced before the street is rebuilt.

In developing plans for rebuilding curbs and sidewalks and installing ADA ramps, modifications will be made to the existing large islands located on the west side of the street. Most of these islands are bare or very poorly planted. In rebuilding the islands, there is an opportunity to enhance the appearance of these islands. We will use Schieber and Associates to assist us in designing this part of the project.

The above will be added to the construction plans now being prepared and final plans will be completed for construction this summer and fall. The additional engineering fee to add these modifications will be a lump sum of \$15,600.


