ITEM FROM THE DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT

1. Johnstown Road TIF Ordinance

Jones said the executive team met and identified the needed public improvements that will be in this area; have proposed a Johnstown Road TIF; will cover Johnstown Road to the south; will go to the Olde Gahanna TIF District; many projects in this area to be funded; such as the bike path along Johnstown Road; other development areas in certain parts show new increment that could be created; also shows potential future park land; the TIF area captures potential development; schools have been notified and they will not be held harmless; everything should be in place and will be sent to the state by the end of the year: Angelou confirmed this does not impact the developer; Jones said it does not impact anyone; Renner asked if this was Mifflin Township Fire; Jones said it will impact their taxes; have notified them and they will be discussing; requesting an Ordinance; Larick confirmed there is no accelerated timeline for this; Jones said the state just needs to be notified; Renner asked that Jones notify him of the concerns of the township.
