


Constituent Newsletter - June 2024

Getting to Work

Highlights of Actions, Projects, and Initiatives

- Have been actively reviewing the proposed 2025 budget and asking key questions
 to ensure we're making fiscally responsible choices that reflect our community's
 priorities.
- Created a resident-led Juneteenth Planning Committee to explore ways our community can celebrate this significant holiday in 2025. Initial brainstorming has already taken place and follow-up meetings held with Parks & Rec and Visit Gahanna staff.

- · Participated in Transportation and Mobility Plan Steering Committee Meeting.
- Reviewed applicants for Community Reinvestment Area Housing Council (CRA).

- Met with resident to discuss increasing civic engagement among the New American community in Gahanna.
