

PARKING AND SHUTTLES

The Festival offers both complimentary "Park & Ride" shuttle service and paid parking.

FREE PARK & RIDE SHUTTLE

PAID PARKING

The Creekside Parking Garage will be open throughout the festival weekend and has an event parking rate of \$5. The Garage is accessible only by traveling south on Mill Street.

- **Festival admission will be collected for all cars entering the garage.**
- **Cash or Credit Cards will be accepted at the garage.**
(Valid pre-purchased online tickets may be presented at garage entrance for festival admission.)

HANDICAP SHUTTLES/PARKING

Handicap shuttle service will be available in the Festival's Free Park & Ride lot, located at 700 Morrison Rd. Limited handicap parking also is available in the Creekside Parking Garage (\$5 per car).

CHAIRS

Although the Festival provides chairs, you are welcome to bring your own folding chairs. (No chairs with umbrellas, please.)

COOLERS

No outside coolers are permitted inside the admission gates.

FESTIVAL MERCHANDISE

Head to the Festival's Merchandise Tent (located on Mill Street, in front of Creekside Plaza) for the Festival apparel and other souvenirs.

FIRST AID

Located at Mill and Town Streets.

LOST CHILDREN

Parents separated from their small children should immediately notify a nearby police officer, a festival staff member, or a festival vendor. Provide a description of your child and your location, and remain where you are until police arrive.

LOST & FOUND

Located in the Volunteer Headquarters, near the Blues Stage.

PETS

Other than service animals, no pets of any kind are permitted at the Festival.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Due to contracts with musicians, no unauthorized photography will be allowed at any time during the Festival.

RE-ENTRY

Same day re-entry to the Festival is available for attendees wearing that day's accepted admission wristband.

SAFETY AND WEATHER

The CBJF is an all-weather event. In case of severe weather or an emergency, announcements will be made from the stages. If operations are suspended temporarily, guests are encouraged to seek shelter in the buildings located within the festival grounds. In the event of an evacuation, guests must leave the festival grounds immediately or seek shelter in the Creekside Parking Garage (located near Jazz Stage).

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited under tents at the Festival.
