WHEREAS: September 17, 2020, marks the two hundred thirty-third anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS: The United States Constitution, including its Amendments, grants certain specified constitutional rights to the American people; and

WHEREAS: It is of great importance that all citizens understand the provisions and the principles contained in the Constitution in order to effectively support, preserve and defend it; and

WHEREAS: Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America, designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week; and

WHEREAS: The United States Constitution is the supreme law of the United States of America and is sustained by Americans who daily defend our principles of democracy and freedom; and

WHEREAS: In remembrance of the ratification of the Constitution in 1787 and in recognition of Americans who strive to uphold the duties and responsibilities of citizenship, the Mathias Ridenour Chapter of the National Society of Daughters of the American Revolution request that the United States Constitution should be celebrated by appropriate ceremonies and activities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Laurie A. Jadwin, Mayor of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, do hereby encourage all citizens to reaffirm their commitment to the United States of America and proclaim September 17 through 23, 2020, as
