

Project updates:

- Ambassador Playground The new playground equipment was fully installed and opened for use in April. Quotes have been received for the installation of a border surrounding the wood fiber with installation planned for later this summer when site conditions are drier. Other site amenities are currently in development (sidewalk, bench, picnic table).
- Sundial at Sunpoint Park An interpretative sign is the only outstanding work item; this sign is currently being fabricated with installation planned for June.
- Upper McCorkle Playground All new playground equipment has been installed and the site is open for use. No additional site improvements are planned at this time.
- Price Road House and Parking Lot Design contracts (architect, MEP, site engineer) are being finalized to allow for re-bidding of all site improvements in Q3 of 2024. Construction is currently anticipated for 2025.
- Aquatics Master Plan Brandstetter Carroll INC. has initiated the evaluation phase of the plan. Staff have submitted the requested data for the consultant review.
- Academy Park Improvements The selected consultant, POD Design, is under contract and a project kickoff meeting was held on May 23. Upcoming work items include site survey and soil borings.
- Action Park A Request for Proposals was published on May 7. Submittals are due on May 31.
- Golf Course Cart Path An amendment with the design engineer (American Structurepoint) is being finalized to update the drawings to resolve contractor questions and improve constructability of the new cart path.
- Woodside Green / Hannah Park Pond Improvements Preliminary recommendations have been received from the consultant, Kimley-Horn, and are under review by City staff.

Adult & Senior Center

- Golf League: 74 participants

Adult Programming

- Pickleball Lesson The May section of adult pickleball lessons began on May 6. It runs every Monday and Friday with sessions for both beginner and intermediate levels. 3 out of 4 sessions are sold out.
- Cornhole League The Summer Cornhole League was cancelled due to low enrollment.

Aquatics & Safety Programming

- Lifeguard classes scheduled for May 2-5 & 16-19 certified a combined 21 new Lifeguards. More are scheduling as we do interviews. All participants are staff for this summer.
- We recertified 10 Lifeguards over two courses in May. All current LG certified staff that did not attend a Lifeguard course in May attended the course as their pre-season inservice training.
- CPRO courses are scheduled for May 5 & May 16-17. Final registrations = 10 including 1 resident.
- WSI course is set to run May 26-30. Course dates were adjusted due to scheduling conflicts. There are 6 candidates in the class.
- Swim Instructor positions are being lowered to a minimum age of 15 (previously 16) to align with new Red Cross standards.
- We closed positions with 185 total applications across all aquatic positions. 128 have accepted offers.
- Splash pad opened May 1. It will be open 8a-8p until GSP opens on May 26.
- Hunters Ridge opened May 25, GSP will open May 26.
- Swim Lesson registration will open on May 20 for June courses. We have 810 spaces for swim lessons this summer across our various types of lessons. (2023 total was 510)
