PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

BRIGHTLINE WEST

MORPC led local leaders to Nevada to meet the President of Brightline West, a high-speed rail project. The agency advances passenger rail planning in Central Ohio and plans to pursue Federal Railroad Administration funding for future rail expansion. This includes both the 3C+D corridor (Cleveland–Columbus–Dayton–Cincinnati) and the Midwest Connect corridor (Chicago–Fort Wayne–Lima–Columbus–Pittsburgh).
