



FRANKLIN SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND GAHANNA WORKING AGREEMENT

This working agreement is entered into on January 1st, 2008 and becomes effective on the date of the last signature. The agreement is subject to the limitations of authorities, resources and policies of the Franklin Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) and Gahanna.

For ease of understanding, this agreement is arranged according to the order of the Six Minimum Controls for the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Phase II for Storm Water as defined with the Ohio Revised Code 3745-39-04 (B)(1) through (6). The activities outlined herein represent Year 3 of the City's storm water management plan.

Franklin SWCD will provide the following services for the City:

The SWCD shall review provide detailed review and comment on natural resource concerns such as soils, drainage, and stream buffers. This review will be completed within two weeks of submission of construction plans to FSWCD by Gahanna.

The SWCD shall review construction plans and make comments related to soil and erosion sediment control practices on the plan as well as the construction sequence.

Review and provide comments on any proposed regulations regarding NPDES Phase II compliance for construction sites. Sample regulations for the city to consider can also be made available upon request.

Perform semiweekly site inspections from approved storm water protection plan (SWPP) and recommend any necessary changes to plan resulting from earth moving activities.

The SWCD shall prepare a brief description of the site inspections and provide same to Gahanna as requested.

The City of Gahanna will provide the following:

Gahanna shall provide the SWCD with a copy of the storm water management policies adopted by Gahanna for the SWCD's use in plan review and comment.

Gahanna shall provide the SWCD with a copy of the Notice of Intent application submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) as part of the NPDES Phase II storm water program, for their records and planning process.

Gahanna shall provide one set of construction plans to the SWCD once received from the developer as part of the plan review process associated with the City Engineer.

Gahanna shall participate in the SWCD's annual planning process.

Compensation

The City of Gahanna shall compensate the SWCD in the form of a grant in the amount of \$48,500.00. All hourly cost estimations are for grant amount calculations only. Franklin SWCD reserves the rights to expend funds as needed to meet grant agreement and overhead costs. Grant amounts can be adjusted annually based upon actual hours spent during previous grant year. Franklin SWCD will not enter into any grant agreement that does not meet our current mission and goals.

Services provided will be maintained by the SWCD. ***A quarterly report shall be provided to the Gahanna that will include:***

Total grant amount
Activities completed in that quarter

In the event that assistance exceeds or is less than the estimated numbers for programs provided, plans reviewed, or construction sites inspected, the next years grant will be adjusted accordingly to compensate for previous years overages or underages. If both parties agree that amount of assistance provided is on target or close to target, the next years grant will be calculated solely on anticipated assistance needed.

It is Mutually Agreed:

That the SWCD is a conservation technical and education service agency and therefore is not granted regulatory authority in the Ohio Revised Code

That the working relationship will be defined to include lines of communications with appropriate departments.

That the City and the SWCD will meet when necessary to review and coordinate activities and programs with the aim of developing a multi-discipline approach to resource management.

That the standards and specifications developed by Gahanna shall take precedence in planning and application of conservation measures. Where the Gahanna's policies are moot, the Natural Resources Conservation Service and ODNR Rainwater and Land Development handbook will be used in planning and application of conservation measures.

That all parties will review quality of service and address concerns as they arise and at least every six months.

That credit will be given jointly to the SWCD and the City in natural resource/ NPDES Phase II related publications prior to publication.

That this working agreement may be amended or terminated at any time by mutual consent of both parties, or the agreement may be terminated by either party giving sixty (60) days notice in writing to the other.

Participation in related planning council meetings is also included in the grant cost.</p> |
| <p>Construction Services</p> <p>Review and provide comments on any proposed regulations regarding NPDES Phase II compliance for construction sites. Sample regulations for the city to consider can also be made available upon request.</p> <p>Perform semiweekly site inspections from approved storm water protection plan (SWPP) and recommend any necessary changes to plan resulting from earth moving activities.</p> <p>The SWCD shall prepare a brief description of the site inspections and provide same to Gahanna as requested.</p> | <p>\$45,000 for an estimated 15 sites at \$3,000 per construction site. This includes biweekly inspections; time spent getting non complying sites into compliance, communications with local government and bi-annual reports.</p> |
