143.03 PART-TIME POSITION.

~~(a) Council hereby determines that effective January 3, 2004, the position of City Attorney of the City of Gahanna shall be a part time position and compensation is hereby authorized and directed in the amounts and on the effective dates declared below:~~

~~Effective January 3, 2004: Forty nine thousand four hundred forty dollars (\$49,440) per annum, payable at the regular pay periods.~~

~~Effective January 3, 2005: Fifty thousand nine hundred twenty three dollars (\$50,923) per annum, payable at the regular pay periods.~~

~~Effective January 3, 2006: Fifty two thousand four hundred fifty one dollars (\$52,451) per annum, payable at regular pay periods.~~

~~Effective January 3, 2007: Fifty four thousand twenty four dollars (\$54,024) per annum, payable at regular pay periods.~~

~~Payment by the City of Gahanna to the Public Employee Retirement System for the benefit of the office holder as prescribed by law shall also be made. It is further stated herein that compensation means salary; any other items, such as staffing, office space, and/or hospitalization, if any shall be determined at a later time.~~

(b) Council hereby determines that effective January 2, 2008, the position of the City Attorney shall be a part-time position and compensation is hereby authorized and directed in the amounts and on the effective dates declared below:

Effective January 2, 2008: Sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) per annum, payable at regular pay periods.

Effective January 2, 2009: Sixty-one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$61,800) per annum, payable at regular pay periods.

Effective January 2, 2010: Sixty-three thousand six hundred fifty-four dollars (\$63,654) per annum, payable at regular pay periods.

Effective January 2, 2011: Sixty-five thousand five hundred sixty-three dollars (\$65,563) per annum, payable at regular pay periods.

Payment by the City to the Public Employee Retirement System for the benefit of the office holder as prescribed by law shall also be made. It is further stated herein that compensation means salary; any other items, such as staffing, office space, and/or hospitalization, if any shall be determined at a later time. (Ord. 0241-2006. (B) EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2, 2012, THE POSITION OF THE CITY ATTORNEY SHALL BE A PART-TIME POSITION TO BE PAID COMPENSATION IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY THREE DOLLARS (\$65,563) PER ANNUM, PAYABLE AT THE REGULAR PAY PERIODS, TOGETHER WITH PAYMENT BY THE CITY TO THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE OFFICE HOLDER AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW. IT IS FURTHER STATED HEREIN THAT COMPENSATION MEANS SALARY; AND OTHER ITEMS, SUCH AS STAFFING, OFFICE SPACE, AND/OR HOSPITALIZATION, IF ANY, SHALL BE DETERMINED AT A LATER TIME.
