537.12 MISUSE OF 9-1-1 SYSTEM/REPEATED INADVERTENT OR MISTAKEN MISUSE

- (a) "9-1-1 system" means a system through which individuals can request emergency service using the telephone number 9-1-1. (ORC 4931.40)
- (b) No person shall knowingly use the telephone number of the 9-1-1 system to report an emergency if he knows that no emergency exists. (ORC 4931.49)
- (C) NO PERSON SHALL, BY MISTAKE, INADVERTENCE OR OTHERWISE, MAKE OR CAUSE TO BE MADE CONTINUAL AND/OR REPEATED CALLS TO 9-1-1 WHEN ATTEMPTING TO MAKE A NONEMERGENCY CALL, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, MISTAKES IN DIALING COUNTRY CODES AND THE USE OF 'OUTSIDE LINE' PREFIX NUMBERS.
- (1) WHERE VIOLATIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION STEM FROM CALLS MADE TO 9-1-1 WHICH ARE PLACED FROM A BUSINESS OR OTHER LOCATION THAT HAS MULTIPLE TELEPHONE LINES SERVICING THE LOCATION, THE BUSINESS OWNER AND/OR PERSON HAVING CONTROL OVER THE PREMISES OF THE OFFENDING TELEPHONE NUMBER SHALL BE LIABLE FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- (D) Whoever violates this section SECTION A OR B is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. WHOEVER VIOLATES SECTION C SHALL BE ASSESSED A FEE OF TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250) FOR THE THIRD, AND ALL SUBSEQUENT VIOLATIONS TO OCCUR IN ANY TWELVE (12) MONTH PERIOD. (ORC 4931.99)
