**AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT AN APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION OF 1.465 +/- ACRES FROM MIFFLIN TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO, TO THE CITY OF GAHANNA, OHIO (JOHNNY TORRES-GUZMAN & AMELIA SIFUENTES-TORRES PID# 191-003163); WAIVE SECOND READING; ADOPT AS EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, an application for annexation of property located off Codet Road, consisting of 1.465+/- acres from Mifflin Township to the City of Gahanna, Ohio, has been duly filed and was granted by the Board of County Commissioners on July 13, 2021; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative to proceed with this Ordinance for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the application of the City of Gahanna, requesting the annexation to the City of Gahanna of 1.465+/- acres, more particularly described in EXHIBIT A, hereto, which territory is contiguous to the City of Gahanna, as approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, on July 13, 2021, is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That an accurate map of the territory, together with the petition for its annexation and other papers in relation thereto and a certified transcript of proceedings of the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners in relation thereto have been on file with the Clerk of Council of the City of Gahanna for sixty (60) days prior to being presented to this Council.

Section 3. That the second reading is hereby waived.


Section 4. That for the reasons set forth in the preamble herein above, this ordinance is declared emergency legislation and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by this Council and on date of signature approval by the Mayor.

At a meeting of the City Council on 9/20/2021, a motion was made by Jamie Leeseberg, seconded by Karen J. Angelou, that this Ordinance be Introduced, Second Reading Waived, and Adopted as an Emergency. The motion passed.


