# **ACTION ITEMS**

### <u>Item #1 – Request an Ordinance for Supplemental Appropriations</u>

The City has been awarded a number of grants for the McCutcheon Park. As grant agreements are being approved and signed the amount awarded needs appropriated to begin the projects. The State Capital grant for McCutcheon Park has been fully executed. I am respectfully requesting an ordinance to appropriate \$245,000 for the State Capital grant from the unappropriated/unencumbered balance of the State Capital Grant Fund 322 to State Capital Grant Projects/Improvements 322.411.5596.

We are requesting an Ordinance for a supplemental appropriation of \$35,000 from the unencumbered/unappropriated balance of the Parks & Rec Donation Fund 227 to Parks & Recreation Donation Capital Improvement account 227.432.5596.

The funds were donated from the Gahanna Kiwanis (\$10,000) and Gahanna parks & Recreation Foundation (\$25,000) for McCutcheon Park development.
