# Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) Representative Report to City Council November 18, 2024

#### MORPC BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

- November 14, 2024
  - a. The MORPC Commission met on November 14, 2024, and covered a range of topics, including updates from the Executive Director, a legislative update, and reports from various committees such as the Regional Data Advisory, Sustainability, and Transportation Policy Committees.
  - b. The Village of Alexandria and City of Marion are joining MORPC as the 89<sup>th</sup> and 90<sup>th</sup> members, respectively.
  - c. Gahanna's Director of Engineering named Vice Chair of the transportation Advisory Committee

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

#### Remembering Tom Johnson

MORPC mourns the loss of Mayor Tom Johnson of Somerset, a dedicated board member since 2015 who impacted Appalachian and Central Ohio through his commitment to growth and mentorship. A public tribute walk and memorial service will take place on Sunday, November 17, 2024, starting at the Old Perry County Courthouse and ending at Somerset Methodist Church.

#### November Legislative Update

- 1. House Bill 315: With MORPC advocacy, revises township law with minor updates and includes housing technical assistance funding; had its 1st hearing in Senate Local Government Committee on November 13, 2024.
- 2. **Senate Joint Resolution 4**: Proposes amending the Ohio Constitution to renew bonding authority for funding public infrastructure improvements; 1st hearing in Senate Finance Committee on November 12, 2024.
- 3. House Bill 257: Allows certain public bodies to conduct virtual meetings with specific policy requirements; 3rd hearing in Senate Government Oversight Committee on November 13, 2024.

- 4. **House Bill 79:** Permits electric utilities to create voluntary energy efficiency programs, pending PUCO approval; referred to Senate Energy and Public Utilities Committee on November 12, 2024.
- 5. Ohio legislators have returned for the "lame duck" session with limited time before year's end; the House has four session days remaining, and the Senate has three, with both chambers concluding on December 18, 2024.
- 6. Governor Dewine is advocating for regulation of "diet weed" or unregulated hemp.
