



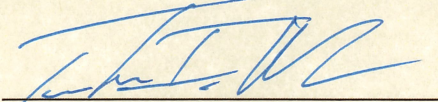
**A RESOLUTION HONORING AND RECOGNIZING THE GAHANNA LINCOLN HIGH SCHOOL

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS**

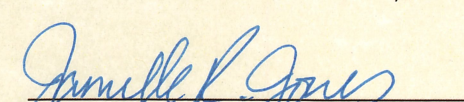

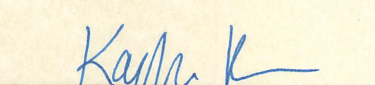
Section 2. *That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.*

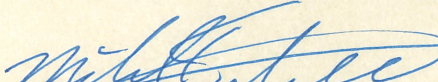

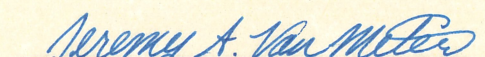
