137.01 DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY
THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR.

137.0102 DUTIES OF SAFETY DIRECTOR.

The Director of Public Safety is authorized and directed to perform such duties as are provided by Charter or this chapter, and such other duties as may be PRESCRIBED BY THE MAYOR provided by ordinance. THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF ALL POLICE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS THAT MAY BE PRESCRIBED BY RESOLUTIONS AND ORDINANCES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OR LAWS OF OHIO.
