ACTION ITEM #1: ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE FRANKLIN COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT (FRANKLIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH) FOR 2023 PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES

Each year, the City of Gahanna contracts with Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) to provide public health services for the City and to function as the City's public health department. FCPH's services include such things as health data, food service operation licensing, inspection and education, healthy homes (lead, radon) inspection and education, vector control education, public health nuisance enforcement and education, plumbing and medical gas inspections, rabies surveillance, retail food establishment licensing, inspection and education, public health emergency preparedness and immunization services. The cost of the 2023 program is \$343,147.30 (\$9.5996 per capita X 35,746 population = \$343,147.30). This represents a 2.2% increase from the 2022 contract.

The Administration respectfully requests legislation authorizing the Mayor and the Director of Public Service to enter into contract with Franklin County Public Health for 2023 health services.
