- (2) Any license issued hereunder shall be revoked by the Chief of Police or his designee if the holder thereof is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this chapter, or had made a false material statement in the application.
- (3) Immediately upon such revocation, written notice thereof shall be given by the Chief of Police or his designee to the holder of the license in person or by certified U.S. mail addressed to his or her residence address as set forth in the application. Immediately upon the giving of such notice the license shall become null and void.

721.99 PENALTY.

- (a) Whoever violates any provision of this chapter for which no penalty is otherwise provided is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.
- (b) Whoever violates Section 721.05(f) is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.
- (c) Whoever violates Section 721.06(a) is guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense and a misdemeanor of the fourth degree for any subsequent offense. (Ord. 288–93. Passed 12–21–93.)
