### **Upcoming Community Events**

Your Franklin County Auditor's Office will be hosting *in person mobile filing events* throughout Franklin County in January, February and March. At these events, staff will assist homeowners answer questions regarding their property values and assist in filing a complaint with the Board of Revision. At select events, we are hosting *Homestead Exemption application clinics* at select events (as marked on the attached flier). The Homestead Exemption is a statewide program that allows qualified senior citizens and permanently and totally disabled homeowners and surviving spouses of public service officers killed in the line of duty to reduce their property tax by shielding some of the auditor's appraised value of their home from taxation. ### **Dog Licensing Reminder**

In addition to being required by state law, dog licensing ensures that any lost dog is returned quickly to their owners. License fees support the Franklin County Dog Shelter and Adoption Center. Dog licenses can be purchased for a one-year period, a three year period or a lifetime period. (attached flier) Licenses may be purchased online at [doglicense.franklincountyohio.gov](http://doglicense.franklincountyohio.gov), or at the Auditor's office license counter, 373 S. High St., 21st Floor in downtown Columbus. *The discounted licensing period has been extended to February 28, 2026.*
