## 131.07 FULL-TIME MAYOR.

Commensurate compensation for the position of Mayor is hereby authorized and directed in the amounts and on the effective dates declared below:

- -Effective January 3, 2004: Eighty-two thousand eight hundred forty-one dollars (\$82,841) per year, payable at regular pay periods.
  - Effective January 2, 2005: Eighty-five thousand three hundred twenty-six
  - dollars (\$85,326) per year, payable at regular pay periods. Effective January 2, 2006: Eighty seven thousand eight hundred eighty-six
  - dollars (\$87,886) per year, payable at regular pay periods.
    (4) Effective January 2, 2007: Ninety thousand five hundred twentytwo dollars (\$90,522) per year, payable at regular pay periods. Effective January 2, 2008: Ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000) per
  - -(1)year, payable at regular pay periods.
  - Effective January 2, 2009: Ninety-seven thousand eight hundred fifty (2)dollars (\$97,850) per year, payable at regular pay periods.

  - (3) Effective January 2, 2010: One hundred thousand seven hundred eighty-five dollars (\$100,785) per year, payable at regular pay periods.
     (4) Effective January 2, 2011: One hundred three thousand eight hundred nine dollars (\$103,809) per year, payable at regular pay periods.
     COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITION OF MAYOR IS HEREBY
- AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED NINE DOLLARS (\$103,809) PER ANNUM, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2, 2012, PAYABLE AT THE REGULAR PAY PERIODS.
- Hospitalization, surgical, major medical, life, dental and vision insurance as set forth in the Unclassified Personnel Salary Ordinance shall apply to this full-time elected position.
