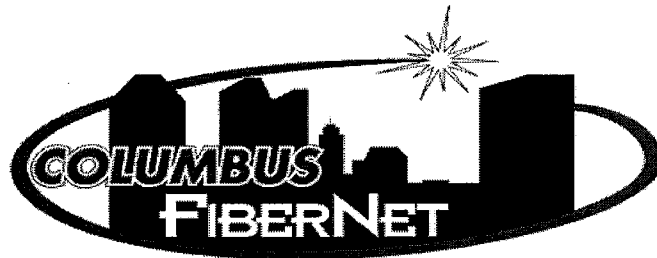

Executive Summary

Thank you for this opportunity. We are pleased to provide you with a quote regarding the above referenced project. Please see the following price and scope of work and let me know if you have any questions.

Scope of Work – Conduit Fiber Install:

- Place fiber in the newly placed TIZ Phase 1 conduit project (built by others).
- At the manhole along Tech Center Drive, splice (144) strands of a Single-mode fiber optic cable to an existing fiber optic cable that routes along Tech Center towards Morrison.
- Furnish 5,200 ft. of 144 Single-mode fiber cable.
- Update the Fiber Maintenance Contract to represent this new section to include:
 - Registration with OUPS
 - Ongoing facility locating
 - Fiber restoration services

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Scope of Work - Aerial Fiber Installation – Taylor Rd: OSP Construction –

- Engineering / working with AEP for pole submittals and IJUS for make-ready assessments
- Build Strand and Fiber – Approx. 2,040 ft. length
- Place Anchors and Guys – 3
- Build Risers - 2
- At the manhole near the intersection of Morrison/Taylor Road, splice (24) strands of a new 144-strand Single-mode fiber optic cable to an existing fiber optic cable that routes up Hamilton to a manhole outside of City Hall.
- On Taylor Road, splice (24) strands of a new 144-strand Single-mode fiber cable to a hand-off tail that will tie into the existing Gahanna 144 Single-mode fiber cable.

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Notes:

- Price included payment to AEP for make-ready fees and engineering.
- Based on the assumption that the conduit is proofed with either a jet line or pull string.
- All tasks in the Scope of Work is quoted during normal business hours.
- All labor prices are not based on prevailing wages.
- Traffic Control is not included in the proposal.

Payment terms are NET 30 for labor upon installation.

CFN reserves the right to re-price should portions of this proposal be changed. Likewise, alterations or deviations from this proposal shall be executed only upon signed approval, which may result in additional charges above and beyond the original estimated figure(s). If we encounter rock, or other impassable objects during construction, we will stop work and renegotiate pricing to continue. All agreements are contingent upon acts of natural disasters, strikes, accidents or delays beyond the control of Columbus FiberNet. All pricing is based off non-prevailing wage rates.
