

Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) Representative Report to City Council December 15, 2023

MORPC Highlights:



• Passenger Rail Announcement – The Federal Railroad Administration has approved two applications for Central Ohio to be part of the Corridor Identification and Development (Corridor ID) Program, a comprehensive planning and development program that will help guide intercity passenger rail development throughout the country and create a pipeline of projects to support future service. The two applications will provide Central Ohio with \$500,000 for each project to expand passenger rail service which will include the Cleveland-Columbus-Cincinnati-Dayton Corridor (3C+D) and the Midwest Connect (Chicago-Fort Wayne-Columbus-Pittsburgh), a critical first step in bringing passenger rail back to the region. The last passenger train pulled out of Columbus in 1979. Since then, the region has grown exponentially, adding more than a quarter million residents in the last decade. *More information here.*

- US EPA Climate Pollution Reduction Grant (CPRG) is a US Environmental Protection Agency program that supports strategies for reducing greenhouse gases and improving air quality. Central Ohio has already received \$1 million to support these goals. The CPRG program has two phases. The first planning phase requires a Priority Climate Action Plan (PCAP) due March 1, 2024. In the second phase, \$4.6 billion will be available through competitive grants nationwide to implement the climate action plan objectives. Currently, MORPC is developing a regional application for this competitive phase two grant. *More information here*.
