Allowable expenditures from the CARES Act funds include improving ventilation within public buildings. The Administration has received quotes for cleaning all the duct work in City buildings to improve ventilation and to clean from repeated fogging in 2020. The cost to clean the duct work in City Hall, the Police Department, Senior Center, and Parks and Service buildings is \$20,065 and will require a transfer of appropriations.
