We are committed to ensuring our families and neighbors have access to gold-standard resources, protecting the integrity of our streets, sidewalks and water systems.


In August, Council authorized the bidding for major neighborhood improvements, including the 2025 Street Rebuild and Sidewalk Maintenance Programwith Waterline Replacement (MT-0008-2025) and the Taylor Road Water Main Replacement Project (MT-0009-2025).

#### Listening and learning

On November 5, 2024, Franklin County voters approved *Issue 47*, a multi-organizational initiative led by the Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA), known as LinkUS. This project promises major investments in central Ohio's transportation future.

With this in mind, several Councilmembers met with COTA representatives to explore potential community infrastructure grants, discuss transit planning, and better understand how LinkUS will impact Gahanna, including trails like the *Big Walnut*, pictured above.






