TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO AWARD CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE WEST GAHANNA GATEWAY ARCH AND POLES

White reported that to get the arch over the bridge and the poles took a great deal of engineering; has to be right height and weight for wind and scroll design so you can see it. The problem is to get it done in time for the Holiday Lights; cannot do hardscape on bridge until ODOT approval; we can do landscaping by fall for parade. The approximate cost for the arch is \$60,000 and \$10,000 for the poles; will take at least 2 to 2 1/2 months to fabricate and then another month to get in place so total 3 1/2 months; approximately October 15th get it back and then about 30 days to get it up; running really close to parade. She would like to go out for bids on the work as soon as possible.

Recommendation: Floor Motion to go out for bids for West Gahanna Gateway Arch and Poles, Consent Agenda.
