### AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PROVIDE CONSENT AND ENTER A PARTICIPATORY AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ROADWAY MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR ON HAMILTON ROAD AND GRANVILLE STREET

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gahanna and the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) are working cooperatively to perform roadway maintenance on SR 317 (Hamilton Road and Granville Street) involving asphalt overlay with minor pavement repair; and

**WHEREAS**, this project will encompass Hamilton Road from the southern municipal boundary, north to Granville Street, and east on Granville Street to Lincoln Circle; and

**WHEREAS**, the work will be completed in coordination with the construction of the Hamilton Road bridge over I-270; and

**WHEREAS**, ODOT has requested legislation pledging the City's commitment to participate financially in said project, including a local share of the cost of pavement repairs, curb ramps, and 20% of pavement resurfacing; and

**WHEREAS**, the Administration has planned for the local share within the 2025 capital budget request, utilizing county permissive tax proceeds, which align with ODOT's planned construction schedule slated to commence in the spring of 2025.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to provide consent and enter into a participatory agreement with ODOT for an Urban Paving Project including asphalt overlay, with minor pavement repair, on Hamilton Road and Granville Street (FRA-317-16.72-18.52, PID 108154); said consent legislation and project more particularly described in EXHIBIT A attached hereto and made a part herein.

**Section 2.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage by this Council and 30 days after signature of approval by the Mayor.

Enclosed is a sample preliminary participatory legislation document for an upcoming Urban Paving Project including asphalt concrete overlay, with minor pavement repair, on SR317 from the railroad bridge until the 270 Southbound ramp, and again after the US270 North ramp onto SR317 to east of Lincoln Circle. # **PRELIMINARY PARTICIPATORY LEGISLATION**

The following is Ordinance enacted by the City of Gahanna of Franklin  
(An Ordinance/a Resolution) (Local Public Agency)  
County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA).

## **SECTION I - Project Description**

WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:

Urban Paving Project including asphalt concrete overlay, with minor pavement repair, on SR317 from the railroad bridge until the 270 Southbound ramp, and again after the US270 North ramp onto SR317 to east of Lincoln Circle. The bridge over the railroad and Rocky Fork Creek will receive deck sealing and upgrading of guardrail.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Gahanna of Franklin County, Ohio.

## **SECTION II - Consent Statement**

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

## **SECTION III - Cooperation Statement**

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The LPA agrees to participate in the cost of pavement repairs, curb ramps, and 20% of pavement resurfacing.

The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

The LPA further agrees that change orders and extra work contracts required to fulfill the construction contracts shall be processed as needed. The State shall not approve a change order or extra work contract until it first gives notice, in writing, to the LPA. The LPA shall contribute its share of the cost of these items in accordance with other sections herein.

The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost to install and/or repair curb ramps at all necessary intersections to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.



#### SECTION IV - Maintenance

Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

#### SECTION V - Authority to Sign

The Mayor of said City of Gahanna is hereby empowered on  
(Contractual Agent) (LPA)  
behalf of the City of Gahanna to enter into contracts with ODOT pre-qualified consultants  
(LPA)  
for the preliminary engineering phase of the Project and to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

Upon the request of ODOT, the Mayor is also empowered to assign all rights,  
(Contractual Agent)  
title, and interests of the City of Gahanna to ODOT arising from any agreement with its  
(LPA)  
consultant in order to allow ODOT to direct additional or corrective work, recover damages due to errors or omissions, and to exercise all other contractual rights and remedies afforded by law or equity.

The LPA agrees that if Federal Funds are used to pay the cost of any consultant contract, the LPA shall comply with 23 CFR 172 in the selection of its consultant and the administration of the consultant contract. Further the LPA agrees to incorporate ODOT's "Specifications for Consulting Services" as a contract document in all of its consultant contracts. The LPA agrees to require, as a scope of services clause, that all plans prepared by the consultant must conform to ODOT's current design standards and that the consultant shall be responsible for ongoing consultant involvement during the construction phase of the Project. The LPA agrees to include a completion schedule acceptable to ODOT and to assist ODOT in rating the consultant's performance through ODOT's Consultant Evaluation System.
