## **EXHIBIT A**

## 331.34 FAILURE TO CONTROL; WEAVING; FULL TIME AND ATTENTION.

- (a) No person shall operate a vehicle without exercising reasonable and ordinary control over such vehicle.
- (b) No person shall operate a vehicle in a weaving or zigzag course unless such irregular course is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law.
- (c) No person shall operate a vehicle without giving his full time and attention to the operation of such vehicle.
- (d) Whoever violates subsection (a) or (b) of this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense; on each subsequent offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. Whoever violates subsection (c) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree on a first offense; on a second offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree; on each subsequent offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree.
