Highlights of Actions, Projects, and Initiatives

- Led the drafting and presentation of a resolution recognizing Disability Pride Month, which honored Gahanna Employability and Adult Readiness (GEAR), GJPS Extended Support Services (ESS) programs, and Gahanna Special Olympics.
- Engaged in initial conversations to plan for Juneteenth 2025 celebrations in the city of Gahanna.
- Conducted interviews with residents seeking appointments to the Public Art Advisory Committee.
- Discussed digital accessibility improvements with Sr. Director of Operations
- Hosted monthly Community Connect to engage 1 on 1 with residents
- Met with Jess Hilts, from Council Office, for her official onboarding and to brainstorm strategies for enhancing our communication efforts and elevating community engagement.
- Conducted mental health research by studying other municipalities, consulting with industry experts, and gathering resident input.
- Attended From Recovery to Resilience featuring the Executive Director of The National Peer Recovery Alliance, which provided valuable insights on integrating effective addiction recovery strategies into workforce development.



Received constituent communication concerning:

- Clarification from the Gahanna Arts Council about their mission, purpose, and their desire to be a strong community partner.
- Resident expressing support for energy aggregation and renewable energy sources.
- From the Board of Directors of the Gahanna Village at Castle Pines Condominium Association regarding the One Church development.
- Resident request for the City of Gahanna to update its civil and criminal codes to address issues related to light trespass, inappropriate camera placement, and neighbor harassment.
