921.03 PERMIT REQUIRED; FEE; MULTIPLE USE CONNECTIONS PROHIBITED.

No connection with any part of the Municipal sanitary sewer system, nor the repair or removal thereof, nor any excavation therefore shall be started without first securing a permit from the Department of Public Service. Such permit must be on the premises where such sewer service connection is being done, prior to the beginning of such work and during the continuation thereof. A charge of eighty dollars (\$80.00) shall be made for such permit to cover the cost of issuance and inspections. Such amount shall be deposited in the Treasury to the credit of the Sewer Fund. The charge for such permit is non-refundable.

No permit shall be issued which contemplates the construction or installation of any multiple use connection. Each dwelling-COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL, RESIDENTIAL, OCCUPIED STRUCTURES, ETC., shall have a separate sewer service connection to the sanitary sewer system, whether or not such dwellings FACILITIES are owned by one person. Multiple-dwellings STRUCTURES shall have separate connections for each dwelling-unit, except where this would create a manifest hardship, in which case the Director of Public Service may grant special written permission (Ord. 980309. Passed 9-8-98.)
