

CHAPTER 159
BOARD OF HEALTH

159.01 CREATION.

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.08, the Franklin County Health Department shall have all the powers and perform all the duties required of a board of health of the City Health District within the jurisdiction of the City of Gahanna. The City shall enter into contract with the Franklin County Board of Health on an annual basis to provide health services.

159.02 ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS.

Pursuant to Section 4.16 of the Charter of the City of Gahanna, there is adopted, for the purpose of public health services to the City of Gahanna the Franklin County Board of Health Regulations related to the following:
