ISSUES:

Carl Norris/Hannah Property Residence - Mayor's memo

Mayor said the house on the Hannah property is very nice; not want to tear down; would be good to have someone live there for security purposes. Carl Norris, Parks Superintendent, would like to live there. It was agreed to obtain fair market value for rental of the house, and then we will separately pay Norris for the security his presence will provide. Mayor is to have necessary information to proceed in two weeks.

Stop Signs - Tim Tam & Venetian Way/Harrison Pond

There was discussion about several intersections and the need for stop signs. Mayor said Engineering will evaluate the intersection of Tim Tam and Venetian after school starts; will study for consideration in 3 weeks. The intersections of Harrison Pond and Belcross, and Harrison Pond and Kames Way were also discussed. Mayor said the procedure is to go thru the City Engineer before we put any stop signs up. Chief said he has been handling complaints within reason; putting more officers in the areas; two bad accidents at Tim Tam; written over 100 tickets in Harrison Pond; extra patrol. Wetherholt will do a traffic study to see if stop signs are warranted. Hogan said he just wants to be sure that the policy is consistent across the City, based on engineering. Mayor said that engineering follows the Uniform Traffic Manual; do traffic counts and accident histories and then Wetherholt makes those judgments on facts. Wetherholt is to come back to Committee with report after school starts and can get accurate traffic counts.
