#### ACTION ITEMS

##### ACTION ITEM #1: RESOLUTION ACCEPTING, AUTHORIZING AND CERTIFYING PROPERTY TAX AMOUNTS AND RATES

The City of Gahanna files its tax budget each July. After the tax budget is filed, the Franklin County Budget Commission then sends each local subdivision a Resolution that must be passed by October 1, accepting the amounts and rates for real estate taxes. The City of Gahanna is in receipt of this Resolution from the Budget Commission. The Resolution authorizes Gahanna's tax levies as necessary and certifies the levies to the Franklin County Auditor. In short, the Resolution sets the distribution of the City's 2.4 mills between the General Fund, the Bond Retirement Fund, and the Police Pension Fund and the amount of the estimated property tax revenue for the upcoming year distributed among each of those three funds.

Consistent with the Ohio Revised Code, the Administration is respectfully requesting a Resolution to accept the amounts and rates as determined by the Franklin County Budget Commission, authorizing the tax levies as necessary, and certifying them to the County Auditor. The resolution must be filed, as required, by October 1 with the County Auditor to complete the certification process.
