ACTION ITEM #1: ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN EASEMENT AGREEMENT WITH COLUMBIA GAS OF OHIO

The existing cell tower located at Lower McCorkle Park (025-004341) is in need of a natural gas service line in order to operate an emergency generator at the facility. Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. is requesting a ten-foot (10') easement to supply said natural gas. The proposed easement runs parallel to the service road that accesses the cell tower. Further, this is the same area as an existing American Electric Power (AEP) easement.

The Administration respectfully requests an Ordinance to authorize the Mayor to accept an easement agreement with Columbia Gas of Ohio. Upon acceptance, the easement will be recorded with the Franklin County Recorder's Office.

**ACTION ITEM # 2 – RESOLUTION OF AUTHORITY TO APPLY FOR FTA SECTION 5310:
ENHANCED MOBILITY OF OLDER ADULTS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES**

The Administration is submitting a request to the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) for Columbus Urbanized Area Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funding from the Enhanced Mobility for Older Adults and Individuals with Disabilities program (5310). This program provides eighty percent (80 of federal funds for capital projects to support alternatives to public transportation projects that assist older adults and individuals with disabilities, new or expanded transportation services, and alternatives that go beyond the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990 for individuals with disabilities. If awarded, this funding would support a new pilot program that provides supplemental transportation services for members of the Gahanna Senior Center.

The application requires a Resolution of Authority to be passed by the governing body of the agency. The Administration respectfully requests a Resolution of Authority to submit an application to MORPC, acting as the designated recipient of FTA funds, for the Enhanced Mobility for Older Adults and Individuals with Disabilities Program.
