- The Commission met on **April 10, 2025**. Due to changes in Ohio Revised Code 121.221 regarding public bodies and virtual meetings, the Commission/Transportation Policy Committee Meeting was aired via live stream.

- CAP Relaunch: MORPC's Competitive Advantage Projects (CAP) Program will relaunch this summer, expanding opportunities for more Central Ohio communities to advance strategic investments.

MORPC Representative Report to City Council

- <u>Economic Development Academy Survey</u>: MORPC is creating its first Economic Development Academy and requests your insights.
- Educational Benefits for MORPC Members: MORPC and Franklin University held an informational session on April 29, 2025, to learn about educational benefits and programs available to MORPC members and their associates.
- Housing Technical Assistance Program: The Ohio Department of Development will offer \$10,000–\$100,000 grants for comprehensive plan or zoning updates, open to villages, cities, townships, counties, and regional planning organizations, starting April 22, 2025, until May 16 or until \$2 million is allocated.
- <u>Leaders Listen Survey Results:</u> MORPC's Leaders Listen survey found top concerns were housing costs, job opportunities, and childcare, with priorities on affordable housing and small business support.
- MORPC Commute Action Fund: The MORPC Commute Action Fund offers \$2,500–\$5,000 awards for companies in the 15-county region to match spending on sustainable commuter benefits, with a rolling application deadline
- MORPC Freight Planning: Central Ohio's proximity to key markets and freight assets, like Rickenbacker Airport, supports over 20,500 freight-reliant businesses employing 351,000 people. Enhancing the freight network is vital for continued economic growth.
- MORPC Hosts Peer Exchange with SEMCOG: MORPC hosted Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG) for a peer exchange, sharing insights on EDD work and strategies to strengthen regional development.
- Natureworks: The Ohio Department of Natural Resources' NatureWorks program offers \$150,000 per county for local governments to fund park acquisition, development, or rehabilitation projects, with applications due by June 2, 2025.
- Ohio House Advances Brownfield Funding in Budget: The Ohio House of Representatives passed its budget, including \$125 million annually for brownfield cleanup; more highlights are anticipated as Senate discussions begin on the budget.
- Passenger Rail News: Sign up for quarterly updates on passenger rail; read more.
- Regional Sustainability Agenda: MORPC held an information session on April 23, 2025, about a collaborative effort to shape a sustainable future for Central Ohio.
- <u>Safe Streets and Roads for All</u>: The U.S. Department of Transportation's Safe Streets and Roads for All program offers \$982.26 million in funding for safety planning and implementation projects, with applications due by June 26, 2025, open to metropolitan planning organizations, local governments, and federally recognized tribes.
