MORPC'S 2025 DATA DAY REGISTRATION OPEN

SHAPE THE FUTURE OF PASSENGER RAIL IN OHIO

MORPC is working with partners from Fort Wayne, IN, to Pittsburgh, PA to bring passenger rail to the region. Now, the State of Ohio Rail Plan wants you to weigh in on the state's rail system. • \$4.9 MILLION AWARDED FOR GREEN SPACE AND WATERWAYS

Five projects in Franklin County have been awarded \$4.9 million for environmental conservation through the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund to support the preservation of green space and the protection of waterways. District 3 NRAC also is seeking nominations for three board vacancies. Nominations are due Friday, Dec. 20. Read more.

MORPC APPLIES FOR USEPA BROWNFIELDS GRANT

MORPC's economic development team has submitted an application to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for \$500,000 Communitywide Assessment Grant. Funds would go toward phase 1 and 2 assessments, cleanup planning, and other assessment activities. Projects across MORPC's 15-county region would be eligible to participate if awarded. Awards are expected to be announced mid-2025.

 April, July, and October
- Eligible applicants: Political subdivisions and non-profits with support from a political subdivision
- Eligible projects: Plans and studies, data collection, education and promotion, short term infrastructure, traditional infrastructure

GRANT FINDER SERVICE

- o MORPC provides a one-of-a-kind opportunity for each member government to be able to access a GrantFinder service, which tracks over 10,000 grants. GrantFinder is a real-time, online, searchable database of 60 billion dollars' worth of sources from federal, state, foundations, and corporate grants available to local governments and their community partners.

• INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT (IIJA)

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (also known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law) was signed into law on November 15, 2021. This legislation is a once-in-a-generation opportunity for Central Ohio and MORPC stands ready to bring this investment back to its members. Based on formula funding alone, Ohio would expect to receive \$9.2 billion for federal-aid highway apportioned programs and \$483 million for bridge replacement over the next five years. There are

numerous other funding opportunities, from earmarks to broadband grants to RAISE grants and more, that could have a transformative impact on your community and MORPC is here to help. As a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and a Regional Council, MORPC is uniquely positioned to provide assistance in finding and competing for these needed dollars. Therefore, MORPC is creating an intergovernmental investment team and hiring a grants officer that will be dedicated to bringing this investment back to our region.
