PENDING LEGISLATION

ORD-0237-2001

TO AMEND SECTION 941.15, PICKUP AND DISPOSAL FEES, FOR REFUSE AND GARBAGE PICKUP, TO BE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2002.

Recommended for Adoption, Consent

ORD-0235-2001

TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH RESOURCE OHIO, FOR MONTHLY CARPET CLEANING MAINTENANCE.

Davies said the last carpet cleaning was \$2,195; would like to start right away with the maintenance cleaning for \$195; especially up stairs with the new carpet; will help carpet last longer.

ISSUES - From Director of Public Service:

Ameritech Easement Request

Davies had distributed copy of non-exclusive easement along Hamilton Road near Shagbark to put in utility box, and repealing current easement. Davies said she is recommending a non exclusive easement; never give exclusive easement.

Recommendation: 1st Reading, Consent; no need to come back.

Sewer Agreement - City of Columbus

Col. Hall said it is not here yet, but when it gets here will have Weber review it very carefully before it comes to Council; this will be for 2002.

ISSUES - From City Engineer:

East Industrial Sanitary Inspection

Wetherholt said that inspection services exceed the contract amount for the Eastgate portion to connect with Crossroads; need an ordinance to add \$9.028 to the inspection contract.

Recommendation: 1st Reading, Consent; no need to come back.

MONITOR:

Water Main Break

Col. reported on water main break near Dark Star and Johnstown; approximately 500 people out of service; will be looking at a faulty valve; may not be tied properly.
