Easement

In consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, william Shadwick and Ethel Shadwick, his wife, do hereby grant to the Village of Cahanna, Ohio of Cahanna, Ohio, a municipal corporation, its successors and assigns, the right and easement to lay, maintain, operate, repair, replace, ramove, and inspect, a drain

tile and appurtenances thereto over and through the following described property:

Situated in the County of Franklin, State of Chio and Mifflin Township:

First Percel:

Being a part of Lot 4 of the Village of Gahanna and more particularly bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot No. 4; thence southerly 45 feet; thence westerly 170 feet to the west line of said lot No. 4, thence northerly 45 feet to the place of beginning.

Second Parcel:

Being pat of the northeast quarter of Mifflin Township, Franklin County, Ohio, and being a parcel of land 10 poles and 9 links deep E. and West 104 feet front N. and S. on the west side of the woad or street in the Village of Gahanna leading due north from the east and of the of the bridge over Big Walnut Creek and being 104 feet off the south side of that pertion of tract of 22.79 acres of land described in a deed from Hiram Harris and wife to Edwin Harris dated April 3, 1877 (and recorded in D. B. 130, page 634, 635, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio), which fronts on the road or street running from Big Walnut Bridge, except a strip of land 34 feet wide conveyed to Jennie F. Biggert by W. W. and R. M. Fisher.

Said Village shall have the right of entry upon said premises at all times for the purpose of laying, maintaining, operating, repairing, replacing, removing and inspecting, said drain tile; all work to be done in a workmanlike manner, (all damages to fances, sidewalks, lawns and gardens caused by laying, maintaining, operating, repairing, replacing, removing and inspecting said drain tile shall be paid for or restored by the Village of Gahanna).

The Grantee shall run two 4 or 5% drain tiles to the store without dost to grantor and each shall have an elbows so that granter can drain water from the roof. Also the grantee shall leave a connection to the north of the drain tile for any future connection by the grantor.

Also the grantee shall place one drop with a bell at the lowest point of the lot where the drain tile runs without cost to grantor.

The grantor agrees that if at any future data the Village of Gahanna shall abandon the use of the drain tile he shall repair, operate, replace and maintain the drain tile at his own expense and there shall be no liability upon the Village of Gahanna to maintain the drain tale; the drain tile shall then become the property of the grantor.
