MID-OHIO REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION (MORPC) REPRESENTATIVE REPORT TO CITY COUNCIL OCTOBER 6, 2025

MORPC SUMMIT ON SUSTAINABILITY

MORPC hosted leaders from around the region to discuss community-driven projects and engagement opportunities to advance Central Ohio's environmental goals.

Sessions explored practical initiatives, from solar-powered air monitors to equitable tree canopy tools, underscoring the importance of working with development to align economic growth with quality of life.

Discussion included Ohio's House Bill 15, which seeks to balance surging energy demand, utility transparency, and consumer affordability.

The keynote reinforced the role of partnerships and innovation in addressing climate barriers, providing timely insights relevant to Gahanna's sustainability work.

KEY FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

ADVANCED ENERGY FUND GRANT

The Ohio Department of Development is offering \$8.5M for energy efficiency projects (e.g., insulation, lighting, HVAC, windows/doors) that reduce energy use by at least 15%. Applications are due this October. Learn more here.- Oct. 31, 2025

BROWNFIELD LOAN PROGRAM

The Ohio Water Development Authority offers loans up to \$500K for Phase II Environmental Assessments and up to \$5M for assessments with remediation. Applications are due next May. <u>Learn more here.</u>- May 21, 2026

COMMUNITY FACILITIES DIRECT LOAN & GRANT PROGRAM

The USDA offers low-interest loans, grants, and loan guarantees on a rolling basis for cities, villages, and townships under 20,000 residents. <u>Learn more here.</u>

DRIVE INVESTMENT

MORPC supports member communities in securing federal funding through tools like the <u>Drive Investment Portal</u> (curated funding notices and deadlines) and GrantFinder (a real-time database of grants). MORPC also partners on regionwide applications, including the <u>HUD PRO Housing Grant & Regional Housing Strategy</u>, <u>USDOT SMART Grant</u>, <u>USDOT Grants – LinkUS West Broad Street Bus Rapid Transit Corridor</u>, and <u>USEPA Climate Pollution Reduction Grant (CPRG)</u>.
